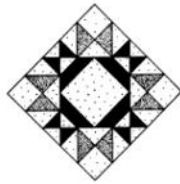

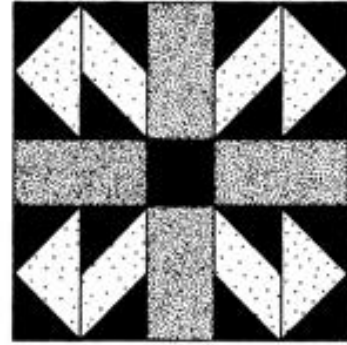

March 8th, 2008

Both treasurers' reports (the general checking and documentation) were reviewed and filed for audit.

A thank you card was received from Coyle Library for our donation of a "Quilted" story for the Youth Room.

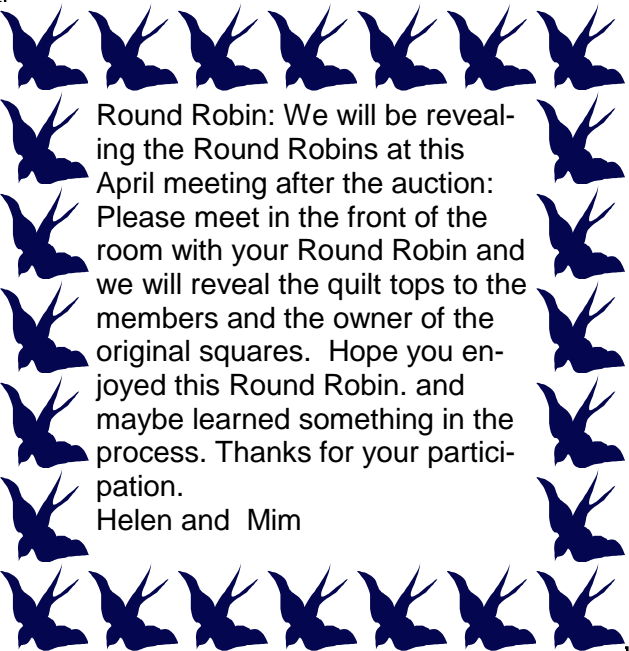

President's corner block



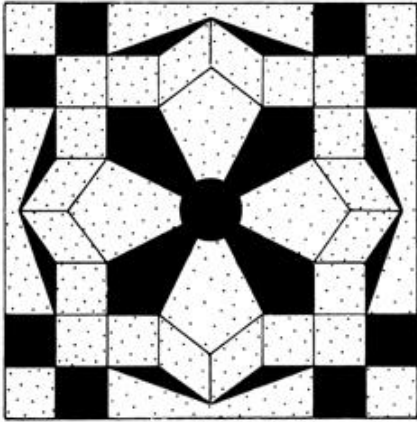
