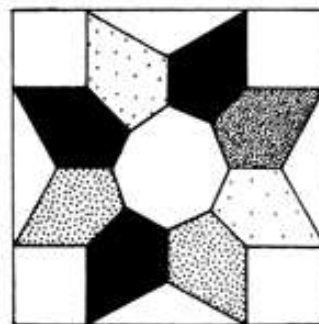

Chambersburg Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes

The Guild meeting was held on 12/12/09 at 12:30pm at Trinity Lutheran Church, Chambersburg PA. The meeting began with a Christmas luncheon followed by the meeting at 1:30. 90 people signed in for the meeting. The last meeting's minutes were published in the Bee Line. The minutes were approved by the members. The Treasurer report was given and approved by the members. The Documentation financial report was also given. New visitors were welcomed.

Old Business:

There are 117 copies left of the **Documentation Quilt book**. The guild has an oil copy of the painting used on the front cover of the book and are looking for a home for the 28x42 painting. It will be photographed and small prints will be made available to members. Need a small committee to determine who should receive the proceeds from the book. **Round Robin** – triangle border is now due. 126 **Doll Quilts** were collected for Christmas giving. A gift certificate from Larry Gore from the **quilt show** was raffled off at the meeting. Twelve packages of Christmas blocks were also raffled off. **Members' pictures** will be taken again in January for the directory. **Retreat** – There were 50 participants who enjoyed the retreat. Next retreat will be April 16 – 18 with sign up in January.

New Business: **Membership dues** are payable by August 1st for the follow-

ing year, they remain the same amount. They may be paid in advance from March through July. Information is in the revised by-laws. **2011 Quilt Show** needs volunteers to chair the show with assistance from the last committee. Maria volunteered to organize the **Lancaster Quilt** trip. **National Quilt Day** is in March and a volunteer is needed to run this program. The **Sunshine** committee gave a report on the health of some of the members and their families. New guild members were paired up with seasoned quilter buddies. January **quilt bee** will be held at Elizabeth Basiliko's house. The three **quilt workshops** for January – March are now filled. **Newsletter** item deadline is due to Cindy Bender by the 20th of the month if it is to be published the following month. Meeting adjourned.

You bring whatever projects and/or sewing machine and spend the weekend quilting while the Roxbury staff feed and care for us. It’s a lot of fun and you get to know other members during the weekend. The sleeping rooms are like 5-star hotel rooms. There will be registration sheets available at the December meeting to sign up for the retreat. You must submit a deposit when you sign up, with the total fee paid by the April meeting. The rates for the **Spring** retreat will be published after the new year:
2009 rates were as follows for a guestimation
Weekend rate – this included 2 nights lodging (Friday & Saturday) and 5 meals starting Friday evening
\$119/person – double occupancy
\$127/person – single occupancy
Extra nights – no food service on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday
\$38/ night/.person – double occupancy
\$42/night/person – single occupancy

If you can’t come for the entire weekend you can come on a daily basis at a nominal fee of \$5/ day unless you order a meal on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, then you will only pay the cost of the meal.

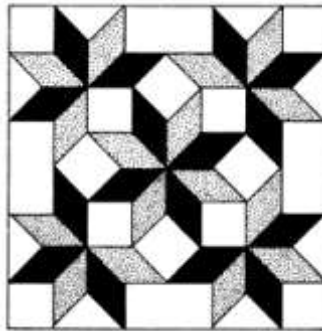

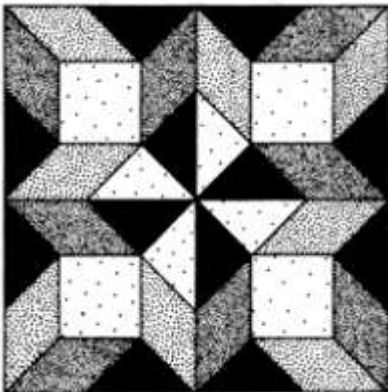

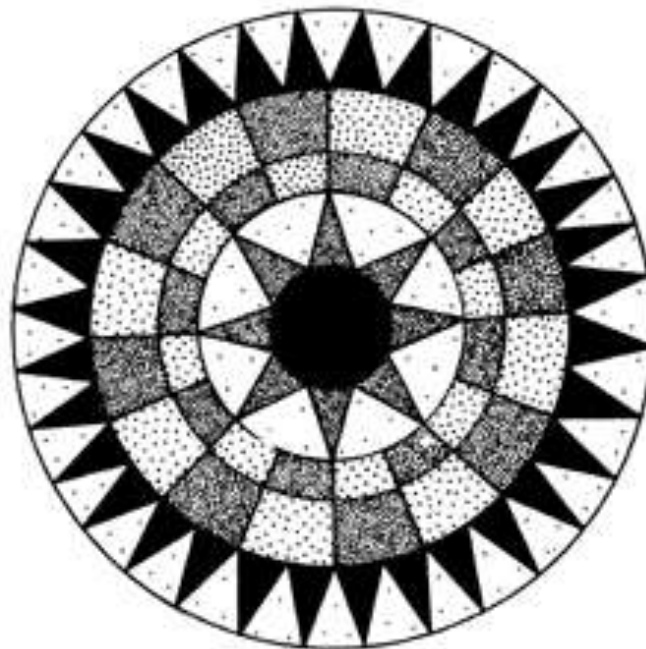
