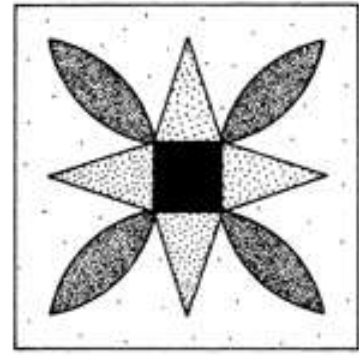

The Guild meeting was held on 04/10/10, at 1:00 pm, at Trinity Lutheran Church, Chambersburg PA. One hundred and two people signed in for the meeting. The last meeting's minutes were published in the Bee Line and approved by the members. The Treasurer's report was given and approved by the members. The Documentation financial report was presented and filed for audit. Members were reminded to wear their names tags.

Old Business: Annual Dues – You can start paying them now for next year. Dues should be paid by August to get into the Directory.

Mystery Bags – remember to pick them up in the back. **Round Robin** – boxes are in the back for pickup. They are due in May.

Friendship Blocks – There are still some available and are due next month. The new **Raffle Quilt Tickets** are ready for pick-up for the next quilt raffle. **Raffle quilt kits** must be turned in by the May meeting. **Retreat** – It will open on Tuesday. If you are attending on a daily basis it is \$5.00 unless you pay for a meal.

Documentation book – copies in the back for \$29.95. Prints of the picture seen on the front of the book are for sale. Ruth Mollack is taking orders for the pictures now and in May. The Conococheague Institute Museum will host a quilt show on Mother's Day weekend with antique quilts on display. The large quilt picture from the book has been framed and donated to the Conococheague Institute Museum.

New Business: Nominating Committee: The list of members for board and committee positions is in this month's newsletter. There were no objections and the members were unanimously approved. They will be sworn in at the next meeting. The next Board Meeting will be 10 o'clock, May 8th before the May meeting. Current members were asked to re-

turn their thread spools. There will be a joint board meeting June 12 at 10 am. Bring your expense sheets. **Doll quilts** – we have 18 finished since November. **Kotemba Japan**, our sister city, will be visited in August. Still need a small 12 x 12 quilt to send, see Helen Lagasse. **Quilt Bee locations** for the rest of the guild year will be listed in the newsletter. The **March Bee** will be held at Dottie Moreland's house. **National Quilt Day** was a success. Quilts finished that day were displayed. They will be donated to "Women in Need". The **Sunshine** committee gave a report on the health of some members and their families.

Challenge quilts are due in May. The theme is "What do I think of in Pennsylvania".

Grand Feast - next month, members with last names A – L should bring a main course and M – Z should bring dessert. **Quilt Yard Sale** - A suggestion was made to hold a yard sale at the church June 4 & 5. Members can purchase a booth space or bring their own table. Contact Darlene Dixon, Dottie Moreland, or Linda Schwalm if interested.

Programs – Linda Schwalm presented her program "Making of a Quilter" for the membership. It included an explanation of color wheels. She also held a workshop in the morning that was well received. **Show and Tell** followed the program and the meeting was adjourned.

Just past the Church of the Brethren, turn left onto Bain Road. Go past the Rock Hill Farm sign to the two story log house at the top of the hill. The Institute is approximately 5.3 miles from route 16.
